

FROM SCHOLARSHIP TO PHILANTHROPY: 64 COMPLETED PROJECTS THROUGH THE STUDENTS FOR HUMANITY INITIATIVE

SFH REVIEW

Since **2015**, our collective efforts have raised an impressive **24.542** through **64** completed projects.

For **9 years** now, Bosana students have all set aside part of their monthly scholarship funds and they continue to do so even today.

This year, our *Students for Humanity* project successfully supported **seven** (7) students and families for a total amount of **3.588 BAM**.

"**Students for Humanity**" is a collaborative fund established by scholarship recipients from the Bosana Foundation. **Each student contributes 2 BAM per month**, with Bosana **matching** these contributions. This initiative is supported by both current and former students, significantly enhancing the impact of this meaningful effort.

This year, actions were implemented in the following municipalities and cities: Srebrenik, Miljevina, Cazin, Visoko, Sarajevo, and Tuzla. Our students have provided assistance to several of their peers.



RACE FOR THE CURE

On September 29th, the **Bosana scholars** and alumni, (Almedina, Marijana, Nađa, Matea, Sunčica) participated in the **17th Race for the Cure**, a race/walk for healing organized in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The team, along with 304 registered teams and 11,500 other individuals from Bosnia and Herzegovina, **joined this walk for healing**. Together, they raised 240,000 BAM, designated for the prevention, education, and treatment support of **breast cancer**.

Afterschool program

AFTERSCHOOL TUTORING FOR ORPHANS IN BIH

Our AfterSchool program offers orphanage children diverse projects, improving grades, developing interests, and providing vocational training.

It builds community, allowing children to share interests, challenges, and successes with peers and volunteers.

We've seen increased volunteer interest, now with over 60 online volunteers and growing!

Giving Back to the Community

The Power of Volunteering: A Year in Review

Volunteering is a **fundamental** part of our foundation's mission. While we provide scholarships to outstanding students, we also emphasize the importance of giving back to the community. Each scholarship recipient is required to volunteer a minimum of **10 hours per month**, contributing to various social initiatives and projects. This commitment not only strengthens communities but also nurtures personal growth, responsibility, and teamwork among young individuals.

Volunteering in Numbers (2024)

In the past year, our students have **exceeded expectations**, showcasing their dedication and commitment to volunteerism. The numbers speak for themselves:

- Total required volunteer hours: 5,090
- Total volunteer hours completed: 5,745
- Hours volunteered beyond the requirement: **655**
- Overall volunteer rate: 112.87% of the required hours (exceeding the minimum by **12.87%**)

The "**Students for Humanity**" initiative donated **4 annual membership fees** to Homework HUB in the amount of 100.00 BAM each for 4 regular HUB members.



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Questions and answers about the Scholarship Program


In July, we organized an online event whose goal was to **share the experiences and advice** of current and former scholarship recipients regarding applications.
